In order to better equip our campers, Colvig Silver Camps offers a small store stocked with essential and personal items for purchase. We sell most of our items at a less expensive rate than you would find in retail stores. Some items from the store may be ordered in advance, while others may be bought throughout the summer.

Attached, you will find a Personal Expense Deposit (PED) Form. This form is used to pre-order items and to keep track of items that campers purchase while at camp. **It is essential that we receive the PED form several weeks before camp begins so that we will have adequate supplies on hand and to alleviate any ordering problems.** There are several sections of the PED form. Please read the descriptions below in order to familiarize yourself with the form and the items sold.

All of the equipment used for trips (including fleece and long underwear) will be distributed to the campers before they depart on their first expedition. CSC clothing and miscellaneous items will be distributed at the end of each term.

1. REQUIRED EQUIPMENT

Each camper will need all of these “required items” for their stay at camp. It is not essential to order these items from us but it is important to be sure that items you purchase elsewhere are of good quality.

- **Two water bottles** – sturdy water bottles with twist tops that will not leak when packed in a backpack. We offer white Nalgene bottles with the camp logo.
- **Cookware** – we offer a 4 cup resealable Rubbermaid collapsible bowl. We recommend that campers have something similar to the above plus a set of sturdy utensils.
- **Compression Straps** – multi-purpose backpacking tool typically used to attach a sleeping bag to a pack.
- **Bandanas** – another multi-purpose backpacking tool typically used for cleaning. Two recommended.
- **Laundry Bag** – we offer a simple mesh drawstring bag.
- **Sleeping Pad** – there are many styles available. We sell ½” thick foam pads that are functional and inexpensive, but should not be expected to last much longer than a few summers.
- **Large Stuff Sack** – at least one is recommended. Nylon sack with drawstring. Used to organize food and clothes within a backpack. New and rental sleeping bags come with a stuff sack.
- **Backpack Rain Cover** – treated nylon cover with a drawstring that fits most any pack. Great for keeping gear dry. A second poncho can also be used as a pack cover.
- **Rain Gear** – our treated nylon poncho comes in a variety of sizes. Ponchos can double as a ground cloth.
- **Flashlight** – smaller flashlights are better for backpacking. If purchasing at home please provide batteries. We offer CSC squeeze-charge flashlights and headlamps. Headlamps are very nice when handling camping equipment but not necessary for younger campers.

2. REQUIRED CLOTHING

Non-cotton clothing designed to wick moisture away from the body helps keep campers warm and comfortable in a moist environment. These items are ordered in bulk in a variety of sizes and colors. Color and size preferences will be taken upon distribution.

- **Fleece** – We offer heavy weight fleece jackets, vests, and pants. You will need a mid-weight layer to complement them. These items are excellent for layering. Jackets and vests feature front zippers and two pockets. Pants feature a drawstring and two pockets. All items are solid color. **Wool/Synthetic Socks** – keep feet warm and dry even when wet. The socks we provide are a blend of 85% wool, and 15% nylon. “Liner” socks aren’t necessary but are recommended for older campers to help prevent blisters. You will need 5 pairs of wool socks.
- **Polypropylene/Capilene Long Sleeve Top & Bottom** – we sell a two - layer long underwear made of a blend of synthetic materials (i.e. polypropylene, wool) designed to draw moisture away from the skin and

provide warmth even when wet. Typical fabrics are 100% Polypropylene or 80% polyester and 20% wool. Also in solid colors. Only 1 top and 1 bottom is needed.

- **Knit Cap** - essential for keeping warm in the outdoors. Our caps come embroidered with the CSC logo.

3. OPTIONAL EQUIPMENT

These items are offered as a service to you, but are not essential

- **Disposable Camera** – Kodak FunSavers: 27 exposure with flash.
- **Compass w/ rotating bezel** – we offer a simple, beginner friendly compass perfect for learning the basic skills of map & compass.
- **Swiss Army Knife** – the Wenger Apprentice model a large blade, a screwdriver, a can opener, and a nail file. *For safety reasons, we do not allow Homesteaders to have or purchase knives.*
- **Gaiters** – treated nylon designed to cover the top of the boot and the calf to keep snow, mud, and dirt out while hiking. Typically only Outposters would need these.
- **Ditty Bag** – small nylon sack with drawstring. Great for organizing gear in a backpack.
- **Stuff Sack** – nylon sacks with drawstrings offered in a variety of sizes. Used to stuff sleeping bags or to organize gear in a backpack.

4. CSC CLOTHING/MISCELLANEOUS

Give your camper memories of camp throughout the year. All items feature a CSC logo. Please be aware that these items **will not** be distributed **until** the end of the term. Color and size preferences will be taken then.

5 & 6. SLEEPING BAGS

You may use the PED form to either rent or buy a sleeping bag from CSC. All of our rental and purchase bags are high quality mummy-style sleeping bags rated to 0° F. You would be hard-pressed to find comparable bags at a more inexpensive price. Please be aware that we **do not recommend down sleeping bags for young or inexperienced campers**. They pack smaller and are lighter than synthetic, but **will not** keep your camper warm if wet. We recommend **synthetic filled bags** simply because they will still keep your camper warm if they do get wet. Rental Sleeping Bags come with a stuff sack and compression straps. If you plan on renting or buying a sleeping bag, please return this form at least 2 weeks prior to camp so that we may plan accordingly.

7. CAMPING BACKPACKS

All campers will need a full size backpack for trips. As packs are expensive and not every child needs to own one, we provide external frame packs for campers free of charge. While it is not always possible to find the perfect fit because of the wide variety in camper size, we can always set your camper up with a pack that will work well. You may want to consider purchasing a pack for your camper if he or she plans on using it in the future or you would like a custom fit. External or internal frame packs are suitable for our program. Be sure packs fit well and can hold clothing, food, and gear for 3-5 days. Most packs from reputable companies will last many years. **Be sure to mark on the PED form (blue) if your camper needs to borrow a backpack.**
