

Travel Information Notes

Whether flying or driving, please return the Travel Information Form (yellow) before your camper arrives so we know how every camper is traveling to camp.

Arrival and Departure

Campers should arrive on the opening day of their term: June 10, June 25, July 12, and July 27.

Campers should depart on the closing day of their term: June 23, July 8, July 25, and August 9.

Please double-check the dates of your term when making flight reservations or plans for drop off and pickup. Also, please remember that the closing cookout and campfire is the night before the closing day.

Since staff are often away from camp immediately before and after camp sessions, arriving or departing a day or more outside of this schedule is not possible. Arriving a day or more inside the camp schedule is also strongly discouraged. One of the strengths of our program is the continuity and depth of the social community that we build each term. Arriving late or departing early is greatly disruptive to the experience of your camper, their cabin-mates, and the entire age group. If you have no other option, please call the office to discuss the possibility of other arrangements.

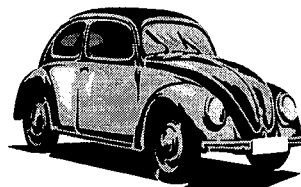
Preferred Camper Arrival Time: 10am-3pm Opening Day

Always check-in at the office so we know who is on Camp property.

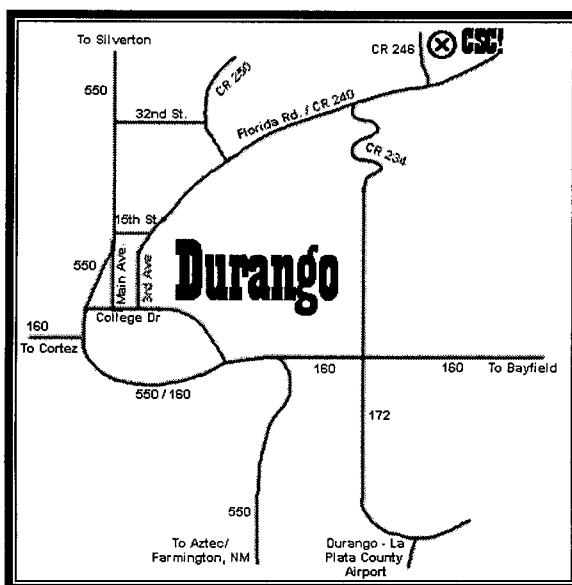

Directions to CSC from Durango

From Main Street in Durango, turn east on 15th Street across from Burger King. In two blocks 15th Street will fork left onto Florida Road (County Road 240). Go 10 miles on Florida Road and turn left at the Colvig Silver Camps sign (County Road 246). Follow the dirt road .4 miles until you see signs for our office on the right. Please check in at the office when you arrive and drive slowly.

Travel Plans

Start your airline travel plans now! Availability is limited!

United and Frontier fly to Durango through Denver.

America West/US Airways flies to Durango through Phoenix.

We will transport campers to and from the Durango (DRO) airport.

When making reservations please double-check opening and closing dates on the enrollment form for your camper's term as well as the Preferred Camper Arrival and Departure Time on the reverse side of this sheet. Book flights accordingly. We recommend purchasing a regular ticket. Passengers with frequent flyer tickets are usually the first bumped in cases of overbooking.

We have been working with **Rio Grande Discovery Travel**, Durango, for many years and recommend them as an option for your travel plans (970.259.2900 or sandy@discovery-travel.net). There is no obligation to use them, but they will be more familiar with the schedules and policies for the airlines that service Durango. Identify yourself as a CSC family.

Unaccompanied Minors

If your camper is under 14, depending on the individual airline, and traveling alone, they require you to purchase an "Unaccompanied Minor" escort from the airline for \$50-\$99 each way. In collecting this fee, the airline is taking full responsibility for your camper from the moment you check them in to the moment we pick them up, including the duration of all connections, delays, cancellations, etc. If your camper is older than the required age, we still recommend that you purchase an Unaccompanied Minor escort for ease of travel, but it is not required.

Please purchase unaccompanied minor coverage for your camper's return trip as well and send proof of payment to the CSC office. If proof of payment is not sent, we have to pay the fee again and charge it to your PED form. We hold all campers' tickets in the office during the summer to assure a smooth return trip. Please indicate that Alexis Harrell, a member of the Colvig Silver Camps staff, will pick up your camper at the Durango Airport.

If your camper will be flying with multiple connections, you may also want to consider purchasing travel insurance, should problems arise en route. One that has been recommended by our travel agency is Travel Guard (www.travelguard.com). Many options are available and you can call our travel agent, Sandy at Rio Grande Discovery Travel 970.259.2900, with any questions.

Important Note: Before purchasing your ticket please consult with your airline regarding their specific unaccompanied minor policy. According to their current policy, America West/US Airways and Frontier WILL NOT fly unaccompanied minors on routes with connecting flights. They will only fly minors directly from Phoenix and Denver respectively.

Baggage & Incidental Fees

When purchasing your camper's airline ticket, please inquire about all baggage fees, overweight baggage charges, and any incidental fees that may arise on your camper's return trip. You may prepay these charges with your PED Deposit or wait for them to be added to your camper's PED account to be billed after camp.

Transportation to and from the airport

We will pick your camper up from the Durango airport and put them safely on the plane at the end of camp. That is why the travel card is so important. Please indicate on the travel card if they are traveling with an electronic ticket or a paper ticket and how their baggage will be traveling. Also, please inform campers of a few camp van safety rules before they arrive:

- ⇒ Enter and exit the van slowly
- ⇒ Wear a seat belt and stay seated while moving
- ⇒ Keep all body parts and objects inside the van
